Industrial Visit - DP World

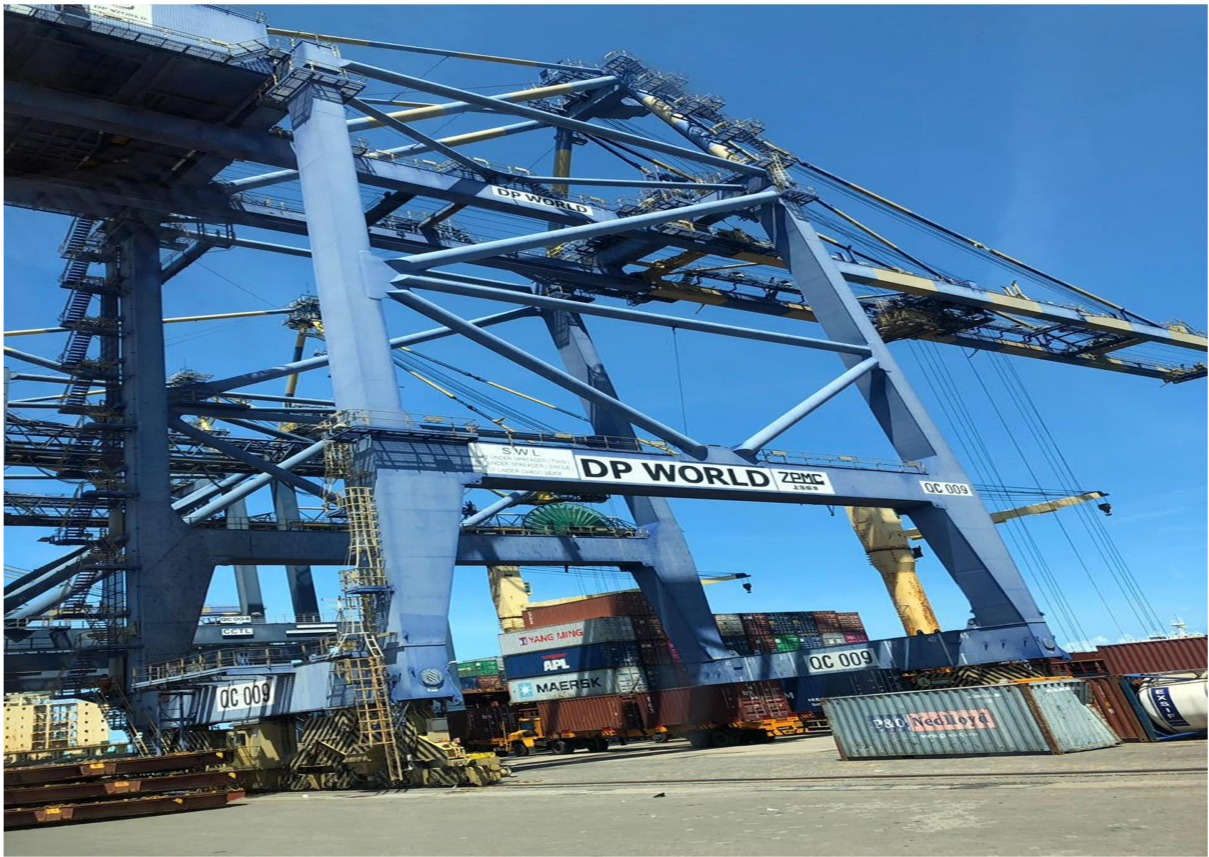
On the 27th September 2019, As part of the curriculum the students visited DP World. Chennai Port is one of the top 100 ports in the world and has been functional for over 137 years. DP world was the first private container terminal commissioned by the Chennai port.

Dubai Port was established in the year 1999. It is a Dubai based supply chain solutions specialising in cargo logistics, port terminal operations and maritime services. It has 150 worldwide operations located in 40 countries with over 73 ports, making them one of the worlds largest marine terminal operators. Its regional headquarters for the Indian subcontinent is in Mumbai. It has 6 operations in India.



On arriving at the port, the students were given an orientation about the operations carried on at DP world along with an introduction to the organisational structure. They perform a host of services ranging from container operations, warehousing facilities and fleet management and provide overall logistics solutions to all parts of the supply chain. The students were given opportunity to clear their doubts on safety standards, quality standards and corporate social responsibility.





The students were taken for a field visit to the loading terminal to witness what they had learned practically, firsthand.

The students gained an overall exposure to the logistical operations and were given a detailed overview of all aspects involved in carrying them out. It was a very educational and fruitful.
