

## World Radio day One day Workshop Report

The Loyola FM Radio Club celebrated the World Radio Day on 13 February 2020 by organizing a workshop for its club members from 9:30 AM to 12:30 PM. Mr.Saba, popularly known as Mirchi Sabha of Radio Mirchi was the guest. One hundred sixty students participated in the workshop.
