PUBLISHING ARTICLES IN JOURNALS INDEXED GLOBALLY
20th & 21st JANUARY 2022

The School of Commerce of Loyola College Chennai in collaboration with the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) and the Office of the Dean of Research organized a two-day workshop on “*PUBLISHING ARTICLES IN JOURNALS INDEXED GLOBALLY*” at Xavier Computer Lab (Jubilee Building Third Floor), on 20th and 21st January 2022 from 9.00 am to 1.00 pm. The primary aim of this workshop was to kindle the interest of the researchers in publishing quality research articles in subscription-based Scopus journals on zero payment. The workshop was actively attended by 50 faculty of the School of Commerce holding their doctorate and also by those pursuing their doctorate.
