Events:

- 1. Volley Ball (Visually Challenged Boys).
- 2. Carrom Board (Visually Challenged Girls).
- 3. Wheel Chair Race 75 meters (Differently Abled Boys).
- 4. Wheel Chair Race 75 meters (Differently Abled Girls).
- 5.Basket Throw Ball (Differently Abled Mixed).
- 6.Pencil Drawing (Hearing Impaired).
- 7. Running 800 meters (Hearing Impaired Boys).
- 8. Running 100 meters (Hearing Impaired Girls).
- 9.Chess Open Category.

General Rules and Regulations

- 1. Only college students are allowed to participate.
- 2. The participants should bring their college Identity Cards and bonafide certificate for verification.
- 3. The participants should be present before 9.00 AM for Bonafide certificate and ID card verification.
- 4. The participants can participate in only one individual event.
- 5. Participants are asked to register with their contact number and college name before 12/12/2019.
- 6. Participants are allowed to participate only in ONE event.
- 7. Participants taking part in individual events [chess {VC}, Wheel chair race {PH}, are asked to bring their own chessboard, coins and wheel chair.
- 8. For pencil drawing materials will be provided by the college.
- 9. Unnecessary arguments and conflicts will lead to disqualifying the particular person or team from the event/s.
- 10. The participants are responsible for their belongings. The College management or the organizers are not responsible for any loss of property.
- 11. Violation of rules leads to disqualification.
- 12. The decision of the referee/arbitrator is final and binding on all participants.
- 13. All the participants are asked to send a scanned copy of college I.D. card for registration.

Rules and regulations for Individual Events

Volley Ball:

Only 9 members including manager are permitted per team.

Only the players are permitted after the verification of ID cards.

Only the captain/vice captain can appeal.

The tournament will conduct as per the adopted volley ball rules.

Rapid Chess Tournament: [Common Boys/Girls]

Time limit will be announced during the event.

Maximum number of the participants of this event is 50. And only 4 participants from each college are allowed.

The participants are asked to be present on time.

The tournament will be conducted as per the AICF rules & regulations.

Carom Board : [Girls]

Maximum 4 participants [B1/B2] are asked to register their names from each college.

Pencil Drawing: [Common Boys/Girls]

The participants drawing should be creative and it should have a theme which will be announced on the spot.
