Short Bio of Dr Subhasis Chatoopadhyay

Subhasis Chattopadhyay's Ph.D. is on Patristics, Christian theodicy in American thrillers and horror fiction completed from the University of Calcutta. He has further qualifications in Biblical Theology & separately, in Formative Spirituality from the Pontifical Athenaeum, Bengaluru. Later he studied the Hindu canon from the Oxford Centre for Hindu Studies. In between he wrote for the (Catholic) Herald in the early 2000s. Then he was the chief book reviewer of Prabuddha Bharata, published from Mayavati (2010-2020), Uttarakhand, which is the mouthpiece of the Ramakrishna Mission headquartered at Belur, West Bengal. His reviews have been showcased by Ivy League Presses on their websites. Further he writes for Indian Catholic Matters where he has begun annotating the Bible through Hindu hermeneutics. He divides his time between Calcutta and Hrishikesh. Subhasis Chattopadhyay was the chief Judge at a pan India Literary Festival in 2017 and 2018. He has taught also at various Administrative Training Institutes.
