

Interaction with Mr. Chimbhudevan

Director Chimbhudevan, journalist and cartoonist turned film maker, was invited on 28th of February 2018 to interact with the students of Film Making. The students were shown some of his works like “23 pulikesai” and “Irumbukottai morattusingam” on the previous day to make interaction more effective.

During the interaction, he said that the directors need to spend more time on pre-production. Involving the team of technicians in the pre-production stage can bring better results. The story board will enhance the production and post-production stages. Hence, he motivated the budding directors to create story board for their short films. He added that the work he did in Vikatan magazine has helped him to make “23 puilkesi”. Further he stated that the journalist career had helped him to be a more responsible film maker. Mel Brooks was his inspiration to make movies in this genre.

Students raised various questions from both the films and he responded to questions in detail. The faculty members also raised questions on VFX and story board to enhance the student’s interaction. Finally, he appreciated the management for conducting film making course in the campus which he said has very good reputation in the industry.
