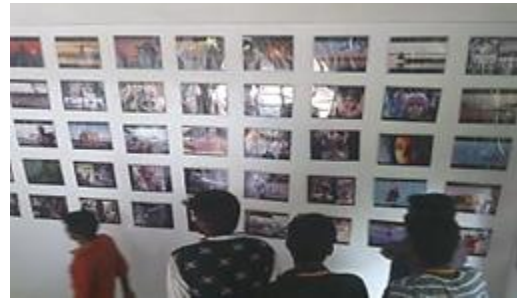


Students Visit to TIMES NOW Network at Mumbai
