Loyola College, Chennai signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with Ministry of Innovation and Technology, Ethiopia to promote academic and research partnership. MOU was signed by Rev. Dr A. Thomas SJ, Principal, Loyola College and His Excellency, Member, Parliament and President of DambiDollo University, Dr-LetaTesfayeJule. DrKrishnaraj, Principal Scientific Advisor, Ethiopia was also present during the occasion.

The MOU would offer DambiDollo University, Ethiopia an opportunity to extend their research wing to Tamil Nadu and its important higher educational institutions like Loyola College to draw practical tips to sustain research and innovation especially in the area

of enhancing the livelihood of common people in Ethiopia.
