Chronology of LOHO 100

- 1924 - Two tower hostel blocks were constructed with 72 rooms.
- 1925 - The construction of the third block, the balcony hostel, began in January with 28 rooms. The first director, Fr Sauliere S.J. was appointed as in-charge of the hostels and he served till 1948.
- 1927 - In July, the admission in hostel reached a total of 280. The 4th hostel block was constructed in November.
- 1928 - There were 11 blocks containing 330 single rooms housing around 550 students.
- 1942 - Two more 3 storey hostel blocks were built.
- 1952 - An addition of two hostel blocks, new mess rooms, a store cum dispensary and a temporary indoor games facility was constructed.
- 1970 - Sauliere Hall was blessed open for hostellers on 31st July.
- 1980 - 22 Blocks were refurbished with gardens at the front.
- 1990 - The student strength of the hostel was around 800.
- 2008 - The guest rooms for students' parents underwent a facelift with renovations.
- 2010 - The grotto of Our Lady of good health at the entrance of the Hostel was erected and inaugurated.

- 2011 - Free midday meal was started for 300 students.
- 2012 - The hosteller's strength rose to 1300.
- 2013 - The fifth block was modernised.
- 2014 - LICET Engineering Hostel Block was inaugurated with 150 students and the volleyball court for the workers was laid.
- 2015 - A new lawn was laid in front of Sauliere Hall.
- 2016 - The mess kitchens were renovated with an additional room. The administrative block that was damaged due to the strike of Vardha storm was renovated. The storm had badly hit the hostel and 678 trees were uprooted. Planting of 1000 saplings was done.
- 2017 - The new mess Metro was introduced and Open stage was built at Teak wood garden. At this time, mess facility was expanded to feed 2000 students every day.
- 2018 - Inigo Kiosk was inaugurated for the hostellers with Wi-Fi and reading facility.
- 2019 - The construction of the new building started. 53 CCTVs in the premises were installed and additional water bore wells have also been installed.
- 2021 - 'A Block' was inaugurated for the students with best facilities.

- 2022 - 30 Mahogany plants were planted near A Block. The strength rose to 1700. CCTC was installed in A Block. LOHO 2 was refurbished. All the LOHO Blocks and common block furniture were refurbished. Mess halls went for major renovation and new interlocked path ways inaugurated. Paver Block road was laid in front of LICET Hostel. Sauliere Hall was renovated.
- 2023 - Office Block and guest rooms were fully renovated and it was inaugurated as Andrew Administrative Block. Pathways between Hostel gate and jubilee mess and veg mess were laid and inaugurated. Arrupe Wellness room was opened and made available for the sick students to take rest.
- 2024 - Foundation stone was laid by Fr. Provincial and the site was blessed by Fr. Rector on 4th Feb for the construction of Building for Co-workers. Refurbishments of common block and toilet doors and windows and a complete renovation of the Kitchen area is done. An LED Display was set up in front of Sauliere Hall. Paver block pathway was laid between Sauliere Hall and Line block.

Services and Facilities

LOHO 100 offers more than mere accommodation. A variety of services and facilities catering to meet the needs of the hostellers, be it sports, medicine, reading, scholarship or spirituals, is exclusively available to support the students to staunchly pursue in their academic endeavours.

Multi-Cuisine Mess Halls

A variety of appetising and hygienic food is served for hostellers and guests at three different mess halls: vegetarian, non-vegetarian & Metro. Also, mineral water plants are available in different places within the campus to provide both hot and cold drinking water.

Counselling/ Career Guidance

At LOHO 100, the psychological wellbeing of the students is profoundly cared for to facilitate a hassle free learning and hence creates a strong mind to carry out the academic tasks successfully with proper guidance and counselling services. Career Guided talks are also given.

Internet Facilities

The Wi-Fi campus provides free internet access to students 24x7 with a high speed for instant references, resources and research.

Scholarship

Deserving students who are socially disadvantaged or physically challenged and deserving do receive financial support and scholarship to pursue their studies comfortably.

Remedial Programmes

Remedial classes are arranged for students on subjects they need special attention.

Health and Physical Wellbeing

Free medicines and medical services are provided to sick students. Also, well-equipped gym, indoor and outdoor games facilities are available to cater to the physical fitness of all hostellers.

Reading Room

An exclusive reading room is open to students to update themselves with daily news and interesting information from dailies, books and magazines.

Guest Room

Paid guest rooms are available for the parents and the guests of the inmates. Students can book the guest rooms in advance by obtaining permission from the Director.

Stationery Shop

A stationery shop is honed within the hostel premises to meet all sorts of stationery requirements of the inmates.

Hairdressing, Laundry and Tailoring

There is a salon within LOHO 100 premises which is open from 9.00am to 5.00pm every day for hairdressing needs of the students. Besides, the hostellers can make use of laundry facilities which is open from 9.00am to 4.00pm at the campus every day. Also, tailoring is available in the campus to stitch new clothes or mend the old.

Activities and Festivities

LOHO 100 not only provides a learning environment, but also promotes various social events, awareness programmes, club activities and cultural celebrations to help shape the overall growth of the students.

Student Cabinet

A cabinet of student leaders help the hostel management organize all events and celebrations like hostel day, terra talents, sports events and other welfare activities in the premises.

Terra Talents & Hostel Day

Every year, a mega cultural program is organized for the hostellers to showcase their talents and caliber.

Pep Talks

Eminent achievers from different fields are invited periodically to give talks to create social awareness among the students.

Clubs and Forums

To help the students develop their personalities and skills, a variety of clubs and social forums are available for them to participate in social services and awareness programs. The students' sense of responsibility to assist those less fortunate and those in need is shaped by the activities, which help them become men for others.

Sports and Games

LOHO 100 organizes indoor and outdoor games and sports to help students maintain their physical fitness. Block-wise and year-wise sports competitions are also held to promote sportsmanship and competitive spirit.

Celebration of Pluralism:

LOHO 100 organizes various celebrations like Diwali, Christmas, Milad-un-Nabi, Pongal, New Year, Ramzan, Onam, Pooja etc. Special meal in sync with the events is provided and seasonal greetings will be offered to celebrate pluralism and to promote amicability and inclusiveness.

DJ Nights

To refresh and rejuvenate the drooping spirit, DJ Nights are celebrated in the hostel campus with fun and frolic.

Blanket Distribution

To promote humanity, On Christmas Eve, Students contribute Blankets and Tarpaulins to the destitute people in streets and camp areas.

Applying for Admission

Admission for Loyola hostel is highly competitive. The selection policies and process are unique. We welcome applicants from diverse social, cultural, economic, ethnic and geographical backgrounds. Admission to the Hostel is valid for one academic year only.

Preference

Loyola Hostel gives preference to students who are Differently abled, orphans, semi-orphans, Dalit Catholics and the students from economically and socially deprived backgrounds.

How to Apply

- The hostel admission application will be made available online for the Freshers and in the hostel office for the seniors.
- Students those who are admitted in the college are eligible to apply.
- If the candidate is selected, he will be notified to be present for the admission process in time.

Admission Process

- Selected students are expected to report by 08.30 AM in the Loyola Men's Hostel office.
- Bring recently taken 5 passport size photographs.
- Fill in all necessary details in Block letters only.
- Submit the filled in application to generate fee challan.
- After the fee payment, get your room allotment, collect your Hostel Identity card and mess coupons.
- Meet Fr. Director to obtain his signature in your Hostel Admission and Identity cards.

Note: Parents meeting will be organised on the same day of admission.



Our tradition and Culture

ALL RELEVANT POINTS OF DISCIPLINE MENTIONED IN THE COLLEGE CALENDAR ARE TO BE STRICTLY FOLLOWED.

On all working days, the prayer music is played at 8:20 AM and the students are expected to proceed to their respective rooms immediately. When the bell rings, the GRAND SILENCE begins and all the hostellers should stand in front of their rooms for the prayer song.

GRAND SILENCE

- A brief multi-religious prayer after the second bell marks the beginning of the Grand Silence which lasts till the start of the time for breakfast of the following day. This helps for the focused study.
- Avoid roaming around the hostel premises during the Grand Silence.
- Use of mobile phones during the silence hours is strictly prohibited. Violation leads to confiscation of mobile phones. No one should be found in others' rooms during the Grand Silence.
- One of the shutters of the window at the door is to be kept open to facilitate the roll-call by the Assistant Directors.

Permissions

- Due to academic, personal or medical reasons, when a hosteller has to go out, LATE - SLIP from the Assistant Director is to be obtained.
- While returning to the hostel after the second bell, the late-slip has to be left with the hostel watchman at the gate and the entry-time will be marked.
- Leaving the hostel during weekends or holidays requires prior permission from the Assistant Directors through the leave forms.

Mess Coupons and Payment Procedures

- Students shall collect the mess coupons on 30th of every month at the hostel office.
- A change of mess can be made at the end of every month.
- No duplicate mess coupon will be issued.
- There is no provision where you can stay in the hostel but not taking mess coupon.
- Mess reduction may be claimed by students who stay in the common blocks when they go on leave from hostel for more than five days. The form is available with the assistant directors. You need to apply for mess reduction before leaving the hostel. Students cannot claim mess reduction after coming back.
- The monthly bill which covers items, such as Mess, Establishment, Maintenance, Labour, Electricity is sent to the parents/guardians by post/ mail. The payment has to be made before 10th of every month.
- If you have lost the Mess coupon, you need to pay Rs 110, 125, 145 per day for Veg. Non-Veg, Metro respectively for the remaining days of the month and receive the mess coupon.

Note:

- Do not exchange the mess coupons with your friends or use other's coupons. Doing so will attract stern actions.
- With permission the Hostellers are encouraged to go for part-time jobs to meet their requirements while learning.



Rules and Regulations

LOHO 100 emphasises strict observance of the following guidelines to facilitate a smooth stay and has a pleasant ambience for the hostellers to complete their academic mission successfully.

General Guidelines

- Hostellers should stay in the room allotted to them by the Director and are not permitted to change the rooms allotted to them.
- Day-scholars are not to be entertained inside the hostel at any time.
- Any extra electrical appliances like iron box, kettle, heater, hair dryer, Extra fans, toaster, etc. are strictly prohibited. Violation will lead to confiscation and it will not be returned.
- Though the campus is under CCTV surveillance, students should take care of their belongings including electronic devices. The hostel management is not responsible for the loss of belongings of the students.
- On any behalf, outside food is strictly prohibited within hostel premises, stern actions will be taken against the violators.
- Students are not expected to scribble, stick posters, banners and pictures on the walls of the room.
- Suspension or dismissal of a hosteller from the college also leads to suspension from the hostel.
- Hostellers who are irregular in attendance or having arrears or disciplinary problems will not be readmitted to the hostel.
- During semester holidays, members are not permitted to stay in the hostel.
- No participation in hostel events may lead to cancellation of admission.
- Students are required to carry their Hostel Identity Cards when they step out of the hostel gate.
- Birthday celebrations are banned inside the hostel premises.
- Wasting or misuse of drinking water is a serious offence; stern actions will be taken against the violators.
- Bathing in Marina beach is prohibited as the water current is unpredictable and dangerous there.
- All students are expected to complete a minimum of 30 hours in the library and record it in the library card provided. It is mandatory requirement for hostel admission next year.
- Wasting of food is a punishable offence.
- You are expected to keep your rooms clean 24/7.
- During the study hour, you are not allowed to sleep or lie down without the permission of Assistant Director.
- Speedy information to Director or Assistant Directors is a must when someone is sick.
- The bathing rooms are kept open at the following timings:
 - 5.00 a.m. to 9.00 a.m.
 - 5.30 p.m. to 7.00 p.m.
- You are not allowed to bunk the class and stay in hostel without any genuine reasons. You are expected to maintain 80% attendance in college without fail.
- Only hostellers are permitted inside the Recreation Hall and the Reading Room.
- News Papers and magazines have to be read at Kiosk only.
- Indoor games may be played at the Sauliere Hall.
- A refund of Rs.3000 will be given as you close your hostel account when you approach the hostel office later after you vacate.

- **Sitting in groups in hostel premises or frequent movements during Silence Hour**
- **Absence in the hostel without permission**
- **Incompletion of 30 Hours of Library Visit**
- **Having less than 80% attendance in college**
- **Having more than 1 Arrear on the date of application**
- **Non Participation in Cultural programs and Sports**
- **Non-involvement in Volunteering Services for Common Functions**
- **Breaking the decorum of silence during Silence Hour (8.30 pm to Next Day 7 am)**
- **Use of Mobile Phone Electronic Gadgets during silence hour for entertainment**
- **Stealing or damaging other's or hostel properties**
- **Visiting friend rooms during Silence hour and staying in other students' room at Night**
- **Misbehavior during common functions**
- **Involving in unnecessary gang formation or fights**
- **Argument with Administrators or co-workers**
- **Found to be involved in smoking, drug consumption or any other prohibited activities.**



Note to Catholic Hostellers



- All the Catholic hostellers are expected to participate in the Eucharistic service daily at the college church, Tuesday Litany at the Grotto and other special prayers and masses arranged at the college/ hostel premises. Others are also welcome.
- At the college chapel, the Holy Mass in English is celebrated at 6.30 a.m. every day and the weekdays evening mass at 6.30 pm in both Tamil and English. On Sunday, the Holy Mass in English is at 6.30 a.m. and in Tamil at 8.00 a.m.
- It is an obligation for all the Catholics to attend all the Masses without fail.

Note to All Hostellers Before You Leave the Hostel

- When a member leaves the hostel, he should meet the Director well in advance. The signature of the Assistant Director and the Block Assistant must be obtained regarding the safety and good condition of the things in the room. The members have to pay the fine for the damage caused, if any.
- The Hostel Identity Card, the Mess Coupons, should be submitted in the hostel office. The outgoing hostellers are expected to claim their credit balance within six months of leaving the hostel.

Note to Parents

- Parents can come at any time to meet their wards with permission of assistant directors.
- The payment for mess fees should be paid by 10th of every month.
- It is the primary duty of the Parents to monitor their wards in studies, attendance and other activities through college website.
- Parents should attend Parents' Teacher meeting without fail.
- Parents are not allowed to stay in the student's room.
