

## **Theatre for Transformation**

**Venue:** Offerr NGO- Navalur

**Duration:** 4 days 17<sup>th</sup> August to 20<sup>th</sup> August 2016

We began our theatre for transformation with technical introduction to Theatre art. We were taught about what is a stage, places in a stage and a brief set of a theatre. Through the 4 days, we were introduced to various postures and facial expressions to communicate a message and to create awareness through theatre play.

Simultaneously dance forms like Kummiaattam, Parai aattam, Oyilattam were introduced and practised. Students were also exposed to integrating and conveying messages through these forms of dances.

By the third day, students had equipped themselves to perform at religious festival in the neighbourhood village. Oyilattam, Kummiattam, Couple of dramas with a social message were performed.

On the last day of the training, students performed various arts they had learnt for the faculties of Department of Social Work.

Students were introduced to social work curriculum which is far different from other courses. We were enabled to learn cultural medium of communication by being outside their comfort zone. This also provided space for the students to socialise, express their social views and ideologies.

Theatre for transformation provided a platform to exhibit talents, explore and acquire new skills. More importantly, it provided the first step to begin the journey to develop socially conscious individuals.
