- Introduction of Social Work profession in France
- Importance of learning Social Work concepts from field work practice
- Challenges in grooming to be a professional
- Need to Acquire knowledge, skills and values of the profession
- Need to equip oneself through voracious reading of books on Social Work perspectives
- Imbibing the process of Social Work Ideology and Principles to help others.
- Available Job Opportunities in France as a Social worker

The lecture was followed by an interactive session, where students clarified the major differences between Social Work in India and other countries, particularly France. The role of social work research in medical field was also clarified.

Conclusion:
