The Alumni members have come forward to provide Tarpaulins to protect the huts from the seeping rain water. It also give a by-cycle to a poor tea vendor to stand on his own legs. 


INAUGURATION OF BIO GAS PLANT




28, 2017 in association with Indian National Science Academy, New Delhi, National Academy of Sciences, Allahabad and Indian Academy of Sciences, Bangalore.
