Loyola and MOP Vaishnav clinch overall titles in athletic meet at Madras university

CHENNAI: Loyola College with 13 gold medals, seven silver and one bronze won the overall men's championship, while MOP Vaishnav College with 14 golds, 10 silver and seven bronze won the overall crown in the women's segment on the final day of the Dr Sir A Lakshmanaswamy Mudaliar Golden Jubilee commemoration athletic meet, organised by University of Madras, here.

In the JC James Memorial individual championships, PS Vishnu of Presidency College with 1061 points was the champion in the men's section, while C Kanimozhi of MOP Vaishnav College with 1055 points was the topper in the women's segment. On Thursday, PS Vishnu of Presidency college stood out as he created a new mark (7.69 mts) in long jump.

Dr R Srinivasan, Registrar, University of Madras presented the prizes and trophies.
