




In our last New Letter, we had covered the activities of the Loyola Alumni in Chennai and other places during the first wave of Covid-19. This time around, during the second wave too Loyola rose to the needs and gave a helping hand. Loyola College Society (LCS) together with Loyola Alumni Association (LAA) generated funds of Rs 5+ million for various activities.

Covid Care Centre:

The entire ladies' hostel of Loyola College was converted into a Covid Care Centre. 325 beds were in place with all supporting facilities. Arrangements for stay of medical fraternity was also provided. Healthy and sumptuous meals were supplied by a reputed Caterer which was sponsored by the Alumni for these patients.

This Covid Care Centre was mainly for the people of Thousand Light Constituency, Chennai with a helpline. This was to help reduce the spread as well as assist in isolation of the affected. Dr Ezhilan Naganathan, MLA of the Thousand Lights Constituency took a lot of interest in setting this up. This was inaugurated by the State Health Minister Mr Ma Subramanian and was attended by the MP of this constituency Mr Dayanidhi Maran, Commissioner of Greater Chennai Corporation and Fr Rector along with Fr Principal.

Tamilnadu Health Minister addressed the gathering and appreciated the efforts taken by our College.



Rev Dr Thomas Amirtham, Principal and the Director LAA presented the dignitaries with mementos.







Oxygen Concentrators:

On 17th June 2021 Action India, Give India together with Loyola College donated 120 Oxygen Concentrators to the Government to be used for the needy. Tamilnadu Health Minister Mr Ma Subramanian and Mr Udhayanidhi Stalin, our Alumni, Fr Rector, Fr Principal and host of others participated.





Covid Care Kit:

Loyola with the support of the Alumni had put together 'Covid Care Kit' from Loyola College containing all necessary items (listed below) in one bag to help people monitor and prevent Covid spread in their locality, with necessary instructions printed in Tamil.

These were distributed to the focal persons identified by the by Loyola Outreach Department from the underprivileged areas of Chennai and Thiruvallur regions. These focal persons numbering around 700 were trained to serve as Covid Warriors in their respective localities. These Covid Warriors worked hand in hand with the Officials of Greater Chennai Corporation and other NGO's to prevent the spread of the virus. This had a tremendous impact on the

people. This prevention activities continue till date and Loyola continues to supply Kabasura Kudineer to these focal persons so that the immunity of the people can be boosted. This became a bottom up approach where the people help each other to protect themselves. The focal persons continue to send reports to Loyola College once in 2 weeks.

Provisions to the migrant workers:

One month's provision in bags had been distributed to nearly 2000 migrant workers covering three districts. This was an initiative of LCS with the support of the LAA. Many alumni had generously contributed to this cause. Jesuit Migrant Service (JMS) and the Loyola Relief and Rehabilitation Service

(LRRS) handled the distribution. Provisions were also distributed to 1000 widows who had lost their meagre income on account of Covid Lockdown.





Loyola Tele Care for Covid (LT4C):



Loyola Tele Care for COVID was set up and handled by Fr M S Jacob SJ and the college counsellors from 5 May 2021 to 12 July 2021. It was functioning every day from 9.00 am till 5.00 pm with four dedicated helplines and fifteen committed full time volunteers catering to 30 to 40 patients in the beginning and about 5 patients towards the end. It has catered to nearly 500 patients on the availability of beds, oxygen, food supplies and

provisions, more importantly provided emotional support to the distressed patients.


Outstanding contribution of our Alumni to the society:
